I wanted to touch base following the announcement from Governor Whitmer regarding the cancellation of the remainder of the school year. Right now, we are still working through the plan on providing educational services, as well as end of the year events like graduation, prom and more.

Right now, I need a few favors from you in order to make sure that we can get through this as successfully as possible.

The first is that our staff has started making phone calls home to every family in the district. This will happen weekly, however it will most likely come from an unknown number. Please answer these calls so that we can figure out how to best meet your student's needs.

Second, all students at LPHS have a school issued email account. Please make sure students are checking this daily. LPHS Staff is working hard to stay in touch and this will be one of the main methods for doing so.

Finally, although Governor Whitmer did lay out a few different paths to progress to the next grade level, all of them still require students to take an active role in off site learning. This is especially important in a credit based, high school program. It is incredibly important that all students do their best with whatever takes place academically going forward.
